Adult Diploma Program at Second Start

Earn a Concord School District Diploma in a way that works for you. Second Start in Concord is offering pathways toward the Adult Diploma that are flexible and can meet your specific needs.

ADULT HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA

An Adult High School Diploma requires the completion of 20 specific credits. These credits may be earned in various ways including at a traditional high school + usually combined with credits earned in Adult Education courses.

ADP Graduation Requirements

20 Credits including:

- 4 English
- 3 Social Studies (1 US History, .5 Civics, .5 Economics, 1 Elective)
- 2 Math
- 2 Science
- 1 Computer Literacy
- 1 Independent Project
- 7 Elective credits

Steps to Adult Diploma

1. Try to get a copy of your high school transcript from your last high school.
2. Call (603) 228-1341 + schedule an appointment with our ADP Director.
3. We'll review your high school transcript, and the ADP course offerings, together we'll determine a plan for completing remaining credits.
4. Register for ADP credit courses.

Spring 2020 term begins in February, unless otherwise noted. Courses meet once a week for 15 weeks, 5:30-8:30pm.

***We must have a minimum of 4 students to run each course.**

Cost: \$140 General education course/ \$70 half credit

\$250 Lab science course

\$75 full credit Plato course/ \$50 half credit Plato course
